New Voter Information Cards Being Mailed to all Putnam County Registered Voters

The Putnam County Supervisor of Elections will begin mailing new Voter Information Cards to all registered voters on Friday, June 24.

Supervisor of Elections Charles Overturf, ask that voters carefully review the information on their new voter cards – including name, address and political party affiliation. If voters need to update any information, please call (386) 329-0224 to make changes. New voter registrations and political party affiliation changes need to be made prior to the August 1 deadline for the Primary Election.

Voters who do not receive their voter information card by Friday, July 8, or have misplaced their card can call (386) 329-0224 to request a replacement card. <u>Voter information cards are</u> not required to vote and are for informational purposes only.

The Supervisor of Elections was required to redraw precinct lines due to recent special redistricting. All of Putnam County is now represented by:

- U.S. Congressional District 3 currently Ted Yoho
- State Senate District 8 vacant until after the election
- Florida House of Representatives District 19 currently Charles Van Zant

Putnam County currently has 35 precincts with 21 polling locations and 46,604 registered voters.
